## Company announces manufacturing plant

Mayor Reed Peterson and Triad Resorts announced Monday that Triad Resorts will be locating a new modular building facility in Montpelier.

The facility will be the first designed specifically to manufacture modular buildings that meet LEEDS certification for green building, using the latest environmentally friendly techniques.

These modular buildings

will be for Triad's new line of ecologically friendly and affordable lodging facilities as well as apartments for the expanded workforce resulting from Triad's developments.

Patrick Howard, Managing Member of Triad Resorts said, "Our new facility will provide about 150 jobs in Montpelier within 12 months as we rollout our new economical motel line, workforce housing and

our initial resort in Jackpot."

Mayor Peterson said, "We are pleased to welcome Triad Resorts and are excited about the positive impact these jobs will have on our community."

Triad Resorts, LLC is a privately held Nevada limited liability company, focused on the development of major entertainment and hospitality centers within certain destination resort cities throughout

the Western U.S. and select international markets.

The company's mission is to bring sustainable economic stimulus to destination communities through responsibly themed resort developments.

Using the buildings that will be manufactured in Montpelier, they will develop a portfolio of family oriented, affordable, themed recreational resorts in communities that are within

four hours driving distance from urban centers. The company's initial resort project, the Spanish Bit Resort and Casino, is being developed in the town of Jackpot located in Elko County, Nevada.

Triad Resorts has located property for the facility and will be visiting the community this month to begin the planning and building process.
